Both	Diversity (Chair: David Rosmarin, From Board: Ben Hankin) As planned, we submitted our Student Diversity Research Award guidelines to the board for consideration and we were delighted that the board approved the award! We are most grateful to the board for their support of our work and clear commitment to diversity science, and to diversifying the ranks of SSCP. In other news, David Rosmarin and Joye Anestis had a sub-committee meeting to discuss the creation of a brief position statement for SSCP (for consideration by the board to officially adopt) on the importance of the clinical science of diversity. An additional discussion surrounded adding inclusive language to all SSCP awards. A third discussion surrounded whether to make a recommendation to the board to revise Article 1, Point 2 of the SSCP by-laws to include a brief mention of diversity. Our committee will meet on Monday, June 8th and make recommendations to the board about these matters following our discussion. We look forward to working with the board on these important matters which would "officially" put diversity on the map of SSCP. In other news, Yeseul Yoon and Sarah Tarbox worked with Evan Kleiman to revise the Diversity section of the SSCP website - there are still a few errors/issues/bugs to work out but we officially have a "Diversity" tab on the top (main) menu of the website which was a big step forward. We will discuss the remaining changes/edits tomorrow during our meeting as well.
